Perspectives from students

- △ OER takes a greater role in teaching, therefore students are involved in teaching and creating OER content (<u>https://www.uni-due.de/ub/en/eoer.php</u>)
- Students look more and more for OER platforms, this can also be attributed to the pandemic and the sensibilisation of teachers and the preparation for courses and the co-creation processes they might be involved
- Networking with other students in an anonymous forum within OER platforms helps reducing anxiety and promotes the exchange of content
- **A** OER creates opportunities for a student body with a broader socioeconomic background
- A The wide range of platforms on the market makes it hard to find the most relevant community. A platform provided by the university could be promoted to all students and teachers, so the access opportunities are equal.

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
