1. Introduction

The development of the seismic courses began during the first phase of the Aurora project. During the first phase of Aurora the following eight courses were offered:

- Università di Napoli Federico II, Re-Thinking Food Systes in the Anthopocene
- University of Iceland, Spark – Your knowledge
- Copenhagen Business School, Introduction to Social Entrepreneurship and Social Entrepreneurship and Business Model Innovation
- Univerzita Palackého Olomouci, Sustainable Social Enterprises
- Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, New Venture Creation in the Amsterdam Entrepreneurial Ecosystem
- Universität Duisburg-Essen, The Enkelfähig Economy – Sustainable transformation of business models
- Universität Innsbruck, Forum Alpbach: Social Entrepreneurship, Innovation focusing and Sustainability

After the launch of the second phase of the Aurora project WP 3 worked towards the continuation of already existing courses and developed new courses. A new course was developed by UPEC and offered for the first time in summer 2024. URV is currently developing a course which will be offered for the first time in 2025. UDE could not offer a course due to unavailable faculty.

The following nine courses were offered in the past 12 months or will be offered in the next 12 months.

- Universität Innsbruck, Sport, Tourism and Sustainable Event Management
- Université Paris-Est Créteil, Emerging Futures: Societal meets Future Studies
- Universitat Rovira I Virgili, (title under development) Financial Plan for Social Entrepreneurship.

2. Description

The Aurora internal regulations will optimise and standardise internal processes, clarify in which moment each decision-making body and management structure shall intervene, clearly define the roles and responsibilities of all the participants and set up the rules for conflict prevention and resolution. This will be done in close collaboration with WP9.

Each university develops their courses. The course offers are then published on the Aurora Virtual Campus. Additionally, each university distributes the information about each course through their own channels. At CBS for example, students can sign up for a newsletter.

Further, the process of making all courses “future-safe” to ensure lasting course offerings for after the end of the Aurora project have been started to make the currently offered courses ‘future safe’ some of the courses will be offered as Blended Intensive Programs (BIP). Therefore, we are working on creating BIP courses across the partner universities with Erasmus+ funds to ensure future student exchange possibilities.

WP 3 was not able to offer a course from Universität Duisburg-Essen in 2023/2024. This was due to faculty not being available. However, UDE has offered courses in the past and is working towards offering courses again.

Additionally, two new courses were or will be offered from UPED and URV.

In 2023/2024 around 289 students were able to participate in the seismic course offers from Aurora partners.
