Course Programme

Why join?

Departing from the [ICI Project](#) (EU best practice) learnings and take-aways, the Inclusive Comprehensive Internationalisation (ICI) BIP contributes to increase and enhance the offer and quality of meaningful and accessible global learning opportunities for all students in Aurora. To achieve this, BIP participants will explore strategies to analyse their institutional context and map their starting point towards inclusive internationalisation. Participants will also learn methodologies and tools to foster inclusive and comprehensive internationalisation at their home institutions and across Aurora with a "train the trainers" approach.

On-site module Tarragona

2 – 6 November 2026

The on-site part is organised as a "train the trainers" staff week to equip the participants to implement and/or promote ICI at their own institutions. Each of the ICI modules will be dealt in detail, with special focus on the roadmap (from concept to action) and a bonus on training skills.

Online sessions

8, 15, 22 October 2026, from 13 to 14h CET

19 November 2026, from 13 to 14h CET

The programme includes 4 online sessions focused on introduction, team building, preparation for the on-site activities and follow-up reflection.

Course content

The programme covers the results of the ICI project from an Aurora-perspective, bringing in best practices and alternative visions. We will explore the ICI framework, guidelines and training modules, including:

1. Diversity and inclusivity in internationalisation.
2. The hidden curriculum and involving ALL students.
3. Boundary crossing collaboration.
4. Inclusivity in an international collaborative online environment.
5. Scenarios and roadmaps towards inclusive comprehensive internationalisation.

Objectives

The ICI BIP will give you the key tools and information to implement the ICI training course at your institution, with the objective to train as many administrative, academics and support staff as possible. We aim to address the challenges that the intersection of inclusivity, diversity and internationalisation brings to higher education institutions (HEI), and to equip them for a truly comprehensive and inclusive approach to internationalisation, from within.

Target group

Leadership, faculty and staff engaged with inclusive internationalisation.

Contents include examples that tackle institutional practices, curricula and services

- The person who attends this BIP will gain knowledge on how to address internationalisation and engage with it in a more inclusive and diverse way
- They will also have a more open perspective about their daily practice
- They will be able to start a process at their own context and raise awareness on Inclusive comprehensive internationalisation.
